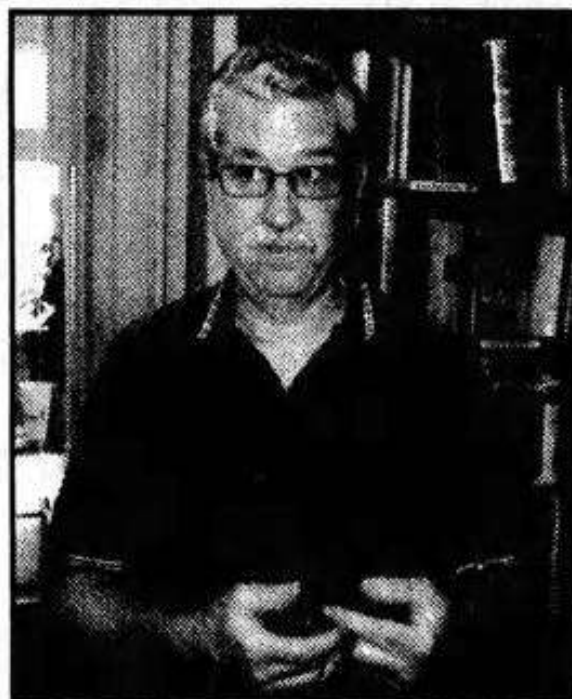
The South Central Virginia Genealogical Society, Inc. held their regular meeting at the Library in Charlotte Court House on April 12 at 1:30 p.m.
